This work is accompanied by a letter of authenticity from Colin Harrison, Senior Curator of European Art at the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford.

The *Voyage au Pays des Pommes* was one of several projects for illustrations for children's stories undertaken by Lucien Pissarro in the mid-1880s, in the hope of finding a commercial publisher. According to the synopsis in sketchbook no. 22 (1888-9), p. 64, there were to be 12 illustrations. Of these, two alternative designs for the title page, one inscribed 'A Trip to the Apple's Country pictured by Lucien Pissarro', and a further design exist in the Ashmolean Museum (Pissarro Archive). Two further illustrations are recorded, one for the Apparition des 1er Habitants and the other this drawing. *Le Défilé Royal* was originally the fifth drawing in the series, but in the revised version of the synopsis (in the same sketchbook), it became the fourth. The project was abandoned in April 1890.
