'Le Grand Andely' and 'Le Petit Andely' make up the town of Les Andelys in Normandy. Having spent some of his summers there during the 1920s, in 1930 Ludovic Rodo bought the Villa Chantereine and divided his time between Les Andelys and Paris for much of the 1930s until he moved to nearby Val St. Martin in 1937.

This painting shows the church at 'Le Petit Andely' (which is the newer part of the town dating back to 1196) with the River Seine in the background, a scene which can still be identified today.
