This pastel on card by H. Claude Pissarro (b. 1935), grandson of Impressionist painter Camille Pissarro, represents Fleet Street in London looking towards St Paul's Cathedral and projects us into the past where his figures are dressed in the 19th century fashion. In these post-impressionist works, his aim is to capture the romantic past, a world which no longer exists, where horses and carts thronged the streets and cars were a new invention. His subjects are drawn largely to his native France, London and Venice amongst other locations. In comparison to other members of the family H. Claude depicted areas of England from his studio in Ireland, where he has been living for over 30 years.
