The Russian-born French painter Marc Chagall (1887 – 1985) who developed a deeply personal and poetic language in his art depicts himself holding a brush and painting a bright bouquet of flowers and a bowl of fruit which were subjects he would frequently paint. Around the painter are multiple characters and animals watching him apply the continuous brushstrokes onto the canvas. A lyrical explosion of colour using images from his memory, weaving reality and imagination into a single legend, one that was born in Vitebsk and dreamed in Paris.
