

Jenkins (1923-2012) was a multi-media artist, poet and playwright, and often titled his works ������������ meaning something that can exist and be observed happening. His way of painting was a meditative process, pouring delicately intense colours of paint, creating layers which have a translucency both in his oil paintings, acrylics and watercolours. By using an ivory knife, he controlled the direction of the paint.

Paul Jenkins was widely exhibited across the United States and he also enjoyed great international

exposure in Japan, South Korea amongst others.
