As an early work, completed during his father Camille Pissarro's lifetime, this painting demonstrates the undeniable talent of Georges Manzana Pissarro. Located on the river Loing, Moret is a beautiful town which was visited by many Impressionist painters in France. Manzana's light, swift brushstrokes perfectly capture the visual richness of the French landscape, and it can be considered a historical snapshot of an area loved by some of France's most revered painters.
