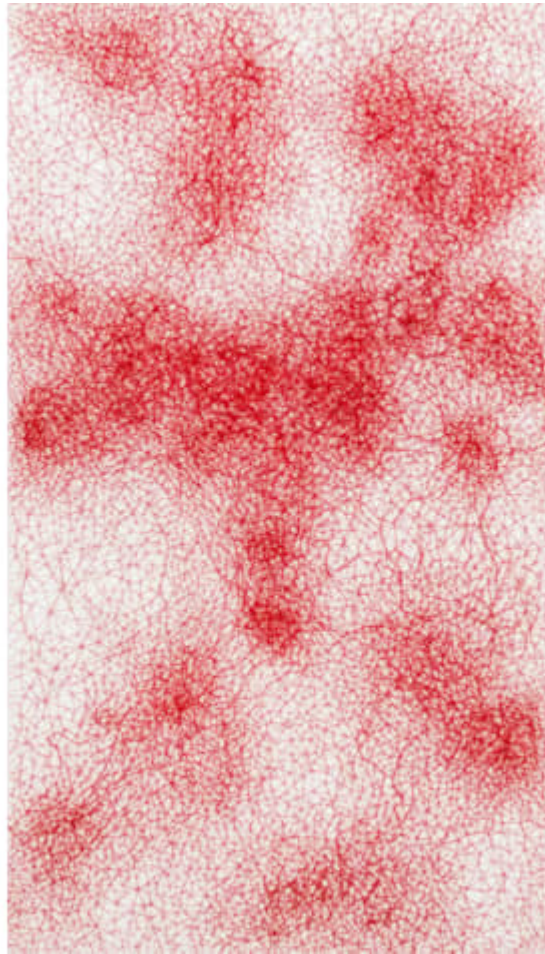

Born in Osaka, in 1971, Chiharu Shiota has established herself as one of Japan's leading contemporary artists. Internationally acclaimed, she is best known for immersive thread installations that map memory and absence.

Executed in her signature red threads, this piece translates the power of her large-scale environments. As she produces relatively few two-dimensional works, it represents a rare opportunity for collectors to acquire a quintessential Shiota at a more accessible scale.
